## ***1. Mobile Virtual Network Operator***

*A mobile wireless communications service provider that does not own the wireless network infrastructure to provide service to its customers*

## ***2. SIM Card - Subscriber Identity Module***

*A physical card used to identify and authenticate an User on mobile devices (telephone number)*

# ***Terms & Definitions*** Continued

## **3. eSIM - embedded-SIM**

*Re-programmable digital SIM that allows you to activate a cellular service from a Carrier*

# ***How “Google Fi” Works***

*Google Fi (eSIM) uses three (3) LTE Systems at the same time.*

*TMobile*

*Sprint*

*US Cellular*

*The eSIM detects which service has the best signal and automatically switches Carriers without loss of service*

# **Phones**

*Pixel 2 & 2XL, 3 & 3XL 3a & 3aXL and 4 & 4XL*

*Motorola G Stylus*

*Motorola G Power*

*iPhone (dual SIM) XR, XS, XS Max, Series 11 & SE (2020)*

*All other Phones (even with eSIM) can only use the TMobile portion*

*Note: Pixel 4 & 4XL can use the physical SIM for a fourth carrier*

# ***Features and Costs***

## **Costs**

*Flex 1 (Single User) \$20 month plus \$10per GB (no matter how much you use max is \$60)*

*Flex 1 Unlimited (Single User) \$70*

## **Features**

*International calls from US. Calls 20c per min. - Text Free, Data \$10 per gb. 135 counties*

*International calls while traveling. Same as above.*

*Free Wifi Calling and Hot Spot*

# **Comments**

*Google Fi is not the cheapest plan, but the added features, three carriers, International calling, Hotspot and Wifi calling makes this a very competitive plan.*

*The real advantage Google Fi is nearly universal coverage.*
